Passages to Recovery writing the next chapter of your life

Passages to Recovery, Inc. provides Drug and Alcohol treatment services to individuals in the community and those involved with the criminal justice system. Passages- Outpatient offices are staffed in the Manor Building, 564 Forbes Ave Suite 930, Pittsburgh, PA 15219. Formerly known as **The Program for Offenders, Inc.,** outpatient services have been licensed to service men and women through individual and group psychotherapy since December of 2011. All information in this report represents data collected from January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022.

During reporting year 2022, 79 unduplicated clients were received outpatient treatment services. The breakdown of participation for this reporting year 2022 are as follows 65 clients newly admitted to treatment in 2022, 11 clients were 2021 admits, and 3 were admitted in 2020 with an average length of treatment of about 109 days.

Reporting year 2022 saw the following length of outpatient treatment 16% stayed in treatment at least 30 days, 34% stayed in treatment at least 3mos, 25% stayed in treatment at least 6mos, 18% were in treatment at least 9 mos., and 6% remained in treatment 12 months or more.

In reporting period 2022 71 participants were referred from Outpatient treatment of which 21 were TLF, 18 received CRS services, and 4 were referred from local magistrates.

During reporting period 2022, 16% reported alcohol as the primary drug of choice, 22% report opioids, 10% reports cannabis, 18% report cocaine, 8% sedatives, 26% report other substances and 16% of the total number self-report co-occurring mental health disorders.

The demographic make-up of Passages Outpatient was as follows, 51% identify as Caucasian, 26% identify as African American, and 11% report as other racial group not specified. The average age of participant at intake is 34 years of age and 98% insured through Medicaid and 2% reported some other form of payment (Private, non-billable or self pay). Participant gender identity 30 female, 49 male, and 1 trans female.

The continuation of the COVID 19 pandemic has had continuing effect on the admissions, completion, retention and accessing community resources necessary for successful treatment for clients. However, Passages to Recovery outpatient has been able to provide individual and therapy with greater flexibility to the individual utilizing telehealth.

Passages to Recovery, Inc. generated an income of \$4,579,979 and total expenses of \$4,492,575 for the fiscal year 2022.
