THE PROGRAM for Offenders, Inc. Alcohol and Drug Treatment Annual Report Year 2019 THE PROGRAM for Offenders, Inc. provides Alcohol and Drug treatment to individuals involved in the Criminal Justice System. The outpatient department located at the Manor Building provided services to men and women in Allegheny County in 2017. These services are designed to meet individual needs and include individual and group therapy sessions as well as psycho-educational lectures. The Treatment license became effective in the Outpatient Department on December 29, 2011. All information presented in this report will be from the first day of the year, January 1, 2019 until December 31, 2019.

During the year of 2019, 185 residents were enrolled into treatment in the Outpatient Department. Thirty-one of the clients enrolled in treatment during 2018, were admitted into treatment in 2018, but remained in treatment into 2019. Three clients remained in treatment in 2019 but had completed their intake in 2017.

In 2019, 151 residents were admitted into the Outpatient Department. The breakdown for new enrollments was as follows: 94 (62%) residents reported Caucasian and 46 (30%) residents reported African American, 8 (5%) reported Biracial and 2 (1%) reported Hispanic. In regard to gender, 77 (51%) clients reported as female and 74 (49%) reported as male.

The breakdown for choice of drugs among Outpatient new enrollments for 2019 was as follows: 87 (58%) residents identified Opiates, 23 (15%) identified Cocaine/Crack Cocaine, 20 (13%) identified Alcohol, 12 (8%) identified Marijuana, 2 (1%) identified Benzodiazepines and 4 (3%) identified Amphetamines.

The Outpatient Department discharged a total of 124 clients from treatment in 2019. Of these 124 discharges, 27 (22%) were successful and 97 (78%) were unsuccessful and were discharged either due to having excessive absences or for being re-incarcerated back into a correctional facility. There were 60 clients who were still enrolled in treatment on December 31, 2019 and of these 60, 46 (77%) had been released from their respective correctional facility but remained in outpatient treatment. Forty-seven (38%) clients were able to be reached following either a successful or unsuccessful discharged to complete a follow up with a Therapist.

With regards to employment, 142 (77%) residents enrolled in the Outpatient Department reported being employed at the time of treatment, and of the 43 (23%) who were not employed and 5 (3%) were enrolled in a schooling program. One hundred and sixty seven (90%) clients enrolled in Outpatient treatment reported having a GED or High School Diploma, while only 18 (10%) reported not having either.

THE PROGRAM for Offenders, Inc. generated an income of \$4,546,606 and total expenses of \$3,816,144 for the fiscal year 2019.
